

Gust of youth in the oldies!!!

This is it!! All the cars of the GT and equivalent cars of the 80's and 90's will have, from 2014, a dedicated race on tracks.

Are eligible, notably, the Ferrari (308, 348 Challenge, 288 GTO, F40 ...), the Porsche atmo and turbo in 4, 6 and 8 cylinders (including the cars of the period Cups like the French 944 Turbo Cup), the Alpine V6 atmo and turbo and the Renault 5 Turbo (including the Alpine and R5 of the European Cups), the Venturi (etc.) and many other cars waiting for a structure to make them race on track like the Group B cars.

The planned format for the meeting would be 40' qualification practice and 2 races of 45' each without refueling. The cars can be driven by 2 people (1 race each).

All the cars will be in conformity with their period regulations and hold a National or an International HTP. Racing tires in period dimensions are permitted.

Nevertheless, the safety of the car will be the safety of the Appendix K of the International Sporting Code. The drivers will be in conformity with the International regulation in application. The Head Restraint Device (FHR) is mandatory
