The Group C grid will put spectacular models of the '80s on the track: Sauber-Mercedes, Porsche 962 and Jaguar XJR.

Spa-Francorchamps Classic will welcome two new grids to Peter Auto meetings: the Challenge ASAVE – Group 1 and its Touring and GT cars that raced between 1947 and 1976 as well as the powerful BOSS GP single seaters, much appreciated by the public in 2010.

This new 100% classic meeting will also be a meeting place for all automobile enthusiasts. Collectors, should they be with a Club or not, will have a privileged place in the paddock with an especially dedicated area in which they shall be able to share views. To be noted for this first edition, a very strong presence of the Porsche and MG Honors Clubs but also the Club Mini Belgium, the Triumph Sports Six Club GB, the Club Datsun France, the Austin Healey Club Nederland and the Club Mazda which will put the Youngtimers in place of honour.

Strolls and shopping will also be on the programme with the Automobilia Village put up in the 40 endurance racing boxes. The occasion to discover or rediscover exhibiters such as Classic Heuer – Vintage Chronographs, The F1 Shop LTD, Auto in Miniature and Classic & Sports Car which participate in the success of many classic car meetings.

The youngsters will not be forgotten thanks to « Little Big Spa ». With a dedicated paddock, budding drivers from 7 to 12 will be able to fulfil a dream and take the start of the "Little Big Spa" parade on Saturday. From the Source bend, through the Eau Rouge Raidillon to the Uniroyal tower, the young motor sport drivers will take over from their elders.

Spa-Francorchamps Classic already promises to be one of the great events of the 2011 classic season. Come and join us on 27, 28 and 29 May to discover the many surprises of this new meeting.
